**BLOOD DONORS GET A CHANCE TO WIN A
BLINK-182 CONCERT EXPERIENCE IN MAY**

SAN DIEGO (May 1, 2023) – Throughout the month of May, blood donors at San Diego Blood Bank will automatically be entered to win a Blink-182 concert package that includes two tickets to see Blink-182 at Pechanga Arena on June 20, limo service, dinner, a 1-night stay at Pendry San Diego and San Diego Blood Bank swag.
