**COMIC-CON INTERNATIONAL TO SAVE LIVES DURING  
48<sup>th</sup> ROBERT A. HEINLEIN BLOOD DRIVE**

*5-Day Blood Drive Collects Thousands of Pints for Summer Needs*

**WHAT:** Comic-Con's Robert A. Heinlein Blood Drive, San Diego Blood Bank's largest and longest-running blood drive, returns for its 48<sup>th</sup> year. This year's theme, inspired by the upcoming Deadpool and Wolverine movie release, invites Comic-Con attendees to unleash their inner heroes and make a lifesaving impact.

All donors will receive a limited-edition Marvel Deadpool & Wolverine T-shirt (while supplies last, sizes subject to availability).

The goal is to break the record of collecting over 3,000 pints over the 5-day period - a goal that underscores the power of community and the spirit of Comic-Con.

To be eligible to donate blood, you must be at least 17 years old, weigh at least 110 pounds and be in general good health. Appointments will be honored first, walk-ins are welcome. Since 1977, the Robert A. Heinlein Blood Drive at Comic-Con has been an important part of the San Diego convention. In its long history, a total of 77,573 pints of blood have been donated by Comic-Con attendees, exhibitors, professionals, volunteers, and staff, potentially impacting more than 232,000 lives over the course of the last 47 years.
