SAN DIEGO BLOOD BANK AND GIRL SCOUTS SAN DIEGO RENEW SWEET PARTNERSHIP FOR SECOND YEAR

Donors Receive Free Thin Mints® Throughout February

SAN DIEGO (February 2, 2026) – San Diego Blood Bank is proud to announce the return of its popular partnership with Girl Scouts of San Diego, marking the second consecutive year of collaboration to encourage lifesaving blood donations across the region.

Forty Girl Scout troops across San Diego and Imperial counties hosted community blood drives from October to January, collecting over 750 pints of blood for hospital patients throughout Southern California. Building on this partnership, throughout February 2026, all donors who give blood at a San Diego Blood Bank donor center or mobile blood drive will receive one complimentary box of Girl Scout Thin Mints® cookies, while supplies last.

This partnership combines two community-focused organizations with a shared mission of making a positive impact. By adding a sweet incentive to an already meaningful act, San Diego Blood Bank hopes to inspire both first-time and returning donors to help ensure a safe and reliable blood supply for local hospitals and patients.

“Blood donations are critically needed year-round, and partnerships like this help us thank our donors while raising awareness about the ongoing need,” said San Diego Blood Bank CEO Douglas Morton. “We’re excited to once again team up with Girl Scouts of San Diego to make giving back even more rewarding.”

“For generations, Girl Scouts have stepped up to serve our communities,” said Carol Dedrich, CEO of Girl Scouts San Diego. “Partnering with San Diego Blood Bank during the Girl Scout Cookie Program season allows us to shine a light on two missions rooted in service—encouraging lifesaving blood donations while showcasing the leadership, confidence, and compassion Girl Scouts develop through these experiences of hosting blood drives back in December and January and running their own cookie business now through March 8.”
